### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

#### REGISTRATION:

**Q** When does registration open for Trinity Woods and Milwaukee Catholic Home Residents?

**A** Earlybird Resident registration opens on Thursday, May 1st. Then on Monday, May 12th registration will open for our waiting list. So register early to secure your spot. Registration closes on August 25th or when the trip fills up. We will be accepting a waiting list in case of cancellations.

**Q** How do I register?

**A** Registration can be handled online at [www.trinityseniorservices.org/fallgetaway](http://www.trinityseniorservices.org/fallgetaway). If you are a resident of Milwaukee Catholic Home or Trinity Woods and prefer a hard copy registration form, one can be obtained at the reception desk.

**Q** Am I able to bring a friend or family member on the trip with me?

**A** Yes! You may register your friend or family member when you register for yourself. The only restriction is that the guest must be at least 21 years old. No minors on this trip.

#### PRICING:

**Q** What kind of payment methods are acceptable?

**A** We prefer that you pay by check, but credit cards are accepted with a 3% surcharge.

**Q** Do I have to pay for the trip when I register?

**A** You must make a minimum of \$100 deposit to hold your spot. The final balance will be due no later than August 25th, 2025.

#### ACCESSIBILITY:

**Q** Am I still able to attend if I need some assistance with mobility or other need?

**A** You may still attend as long as you bring an aide or family member who will be available to assist you. Your aide will have to register and pay for a spot on the trip.

**Q** May I attend this trip if I use a walker?

**A** Yes! As long as you are able to navigate a step or two on your own (i.e. getting on and off the bus) you may attend.

**Q** How much walking will be involved in this trip?

**A** We consider this an activity with MODERATE physical activity. There will be some walking involved and getting on and off the bus. Note: there is no wheelchair lift on the bus.

**Q** On what kind of a bus will we be traveling?

**A** This will be a comfortable coach bus with an onboard restroom. Note: The bus is NOT equipped with a wheelchair lift.

#### ACCOMMODATIONS:

**Q** What are the sleeping accommodations like?

**A** You have the choice of a single, double, triple or quad room. The various prices are explained on the registration form. We will not match people with roommates and ask that you please provide the name(s) at time of registration of who you will be rooming with.

#### OTHER:

**Q** Can we bring our own food and drink to enjoy on the bus?

**A** Yes! Although it is not a very long bus ride (3-4 hours) you are welcome to bring whatever snacks and drinks you wish, including alcohol. And you are welcome to share with your fellow passengers or escorts!
