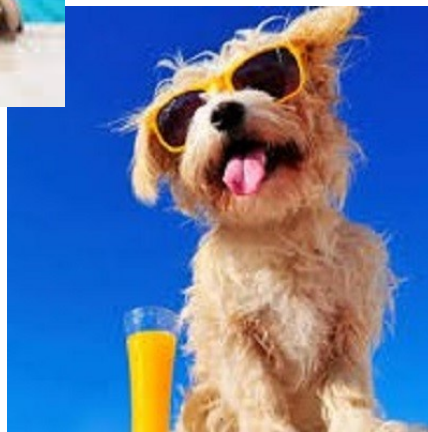
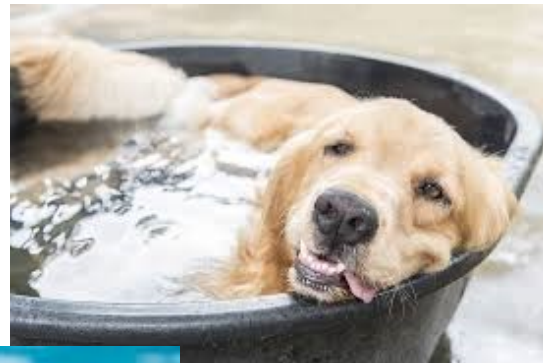


### What's Happening in the Neighborhood this Weekend:
