This endowment was established to assist residents experiencing unexpected financial hardship to remain in their apartments and to receive assistance in their time of need.

The Chaplaincy Endowment:

This endowment provides ongoing funding for spiritual and pastoral care programming and staffing at this community, ensuring that our Catholic identity remains strong as our organization grows and changes.

The Employee Appreciation Fund:

The Employee Appreciation Fund offers residents and their families a meaningful way to recognize the dedication of Milwaukee Catholic Home's staff. Every dollar contributed goes directly to our employees and is shared equitably among them each year during the holiday season, providing a heartfelt thank-you to those who serve our community with care and commitment.

The Clare Gardens Fund: Located at the Catholic Ecology Center in Neosho, Clare Gardens is our sustainable farm-to-table program that produces over 30,000 pounds of organic produce annually for Milwaukee Catholic Home and other senior living communities. Visits to Clare Gardens provide opportunities for social and educational

programming for residents, family, staff and community partners.
