Friendly Reminders!

Library check out: When checking out a library book, it is important to record it on the library log sheet. The log sheet keeps track of which books have been borrowed, who has them, and when they are returned. This helps the library stay organized and makes it easier to know where each book is. Recording books correctly also helps prevent books from getting lost or misplaced. It allows library volunteers to keep accurate records and ensures that other residents can find and borrow the books they need. Taking a few extra seconds to fill out the log sheet properly helps keep the library organized and makes the checkout process easier for everyone.

Signing out: It is important that all residents sign out at the front desk whenever they leave the building. Signing out helps administration maintain an accurate record of who is currently in the building and who has left. This information is especially important for safety and emergency situations. If you are leaving through an exit other than the main entrance, you could also call down to the Front Desk before leaving. The receptionist can then sign you out.
